OUR ACHIEVEMENTS FROM 1997 TO 2012

PREVENTION OF AIDS/STI

- Achieving of 230 school conferences in Jacmel
- Achieving of 250 community conferences in Jacmel
- Training of 60 health promoters
- Establishment of 25 centers of distribution of condoms and awareness materials
- 80 sessions for pregnant women
- Facilitation of 600 screening tests for pregnant women
- Establishment of a radio program for youth
- Distribution of more than 500,000 condoms
- Distribution of 7,500 flyers, 3,000 stickers
- Etc

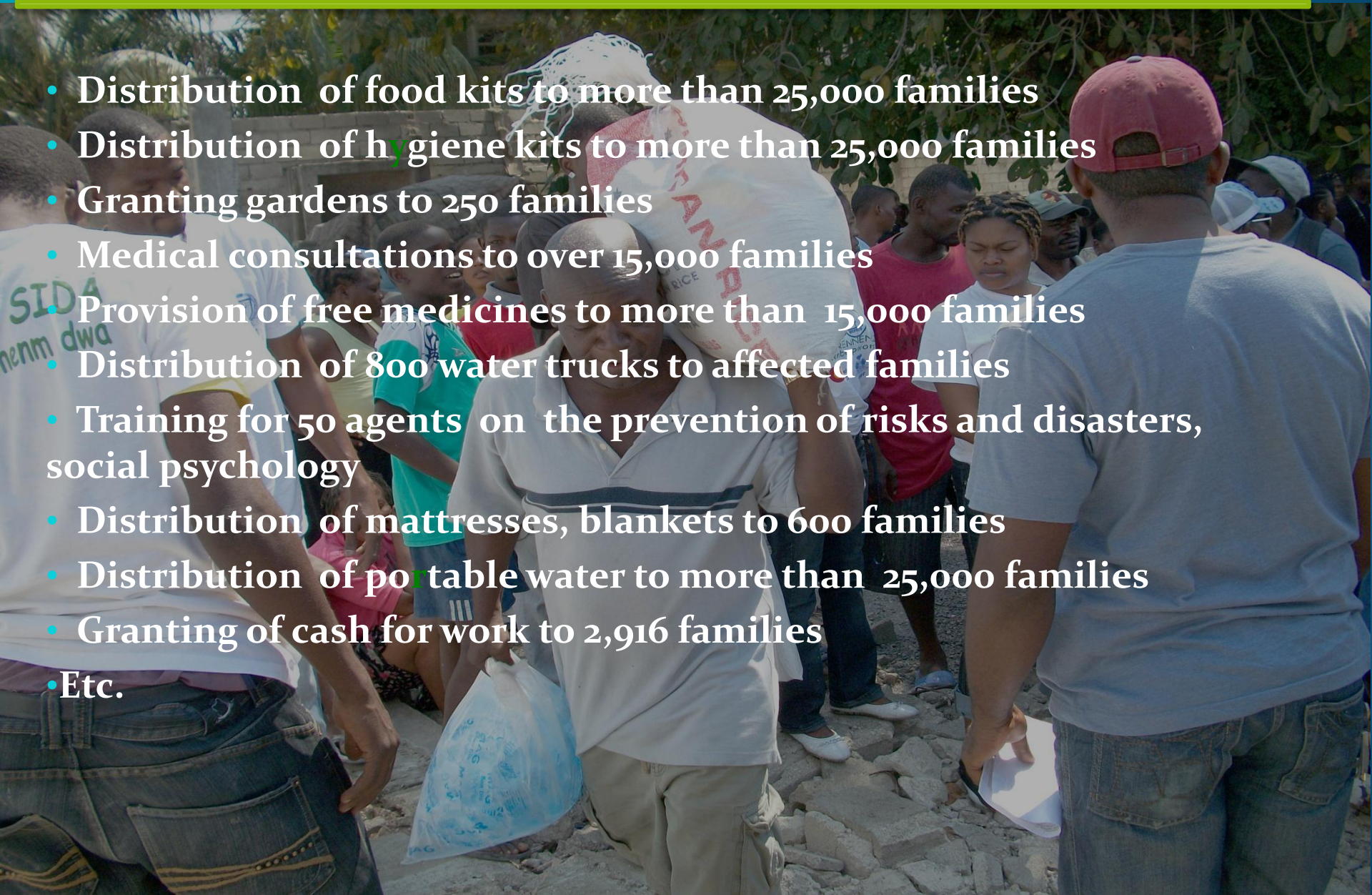


COMMUNITY HEALTH

- Construction of a Center for Primary Health Attention
- Construction of 600 latrines in the Municipality of Ganthier
- Distribution of 4,000 water purifiers system (bokit system) in Ganthier
- Completion of more than 120 medical operatives (mobile clinic)
- Provision of free medicines to more than 30,000 families
- Training of 80 community health workers
- Distribution of 200,000 mosquito nets to families in Croix-des-Bouquets and Ganthier
- Achievement of 48 conferences on the environment
- Completion of 72 educational conferences on the prevention of diseases
- Support to Health Ministry – Deworming campaign in Croix-des-Bouquets
- Etc.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

- Distribution of food kits to more than 25,000 families
- Distribution of hygiene kits to more than 25,000 families
- Granting gardens to 250 families
- Medical consultations to over 15,000 families
- Provision of free medicines to more than 15,000 families
- Distribution of 800 water trucks to affected families
- Training for 50 agents on the prevention of risks and disasters, social psychology
- Distribution of mattresses, blankets to 600 families
- Distribution of portable water to more than 25,000 families
- Granting of cash for work to 2,916 families

 - Distribution of 250 kits of materials to 55 craft workshops
 - Creating of a website for artisans in Jacmel
 - Rehabilitation of the city-hall of Cayes-Jacmel
 - Awareness of 2,916 families of Cayes-Jacmel on the prevention of risks and disasters
 - Achieving 160 workshops on domestic violence
 - Achieving 160 workshops on soil conservation
 - Reforestation (160,000 seedlings miscellaneous) in the Municipality of Cayes-Jacmel
